

Jesus' Death, Burial, & Resurrection

Whether you know the story or not, Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection is the greatest event ever recorded. All four of the gospels, Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John, wrote the story in their books, and today we'll look at Mark's record.
